Offer information and training to people who use support, or their carers, about the responsibilities of becoming an employer.

To offer free training to personal support assistants who work for an individual as their employer.

Enable unemployed people or people who wish to change their job, to find out more about the option of working as personal support assistants.

Create a network of people who can share their experiences and ideas to improve the support they get or the support they give.

The course runs for 4 days but each learner will attend for 3 days. All learners will do Day 1 and Day 4.

People who are considering becoming employers will attend Day 2 also.

People who work as or are considering working as personal support assistants will attend Day 3 also.
